NOTE:

- Parents are required to pay the Annual Fee on or before the last date mentioned in the calendar. If the payment falls due beyond the given time schedule a late fee of Rs.1000/- per day during the 1st week & a late fee of Rs.2000/- per day post 1st week will be imposed on the fee defaulters.
- Parents can meet the respective teachers with the prior permission of the Principal on dates other than those mentioned in the Calendar to know about their ward's academic performance.
- Nature camps, trekking, workshops etc., will be conducted throughout the year as and when it is convenient.
- Interhouse activities will be conducted every Saturday between 2.00 p.m. and 4.00 p.m. for classes VI and above.
- Interhouse activities will be conducted on Wednesdays between 2.50 p.m. and 4.00 p.m. for classes I to V
- PUC Examination, CET, JEE, NEET schedule will depend on PU Board announcements.
- Students are not permitted to keep cell phones with them.
- We appreciate if parents / visitors do not use their cell phones in the school campus.
- Parents of Day Boarders are requested to keep the required digital devices ready, as classes will be held online during rain holidays.
- We appreciate parents who adhere to the school calendar strictly. We may be forced to penalise those who do not abide by the school rules.

EVERYTHING YOU NEED TO KNOW:

To ensure smooth academic work and to maintain discipline on campus, students and parents are requested to adhere to the following rules and regulations.

- We appreciate if parents don't send their relatives to school to meet their wards.
- Parents / Guardians can meet their wards only in case of emergency, obtaining permission from the Principal. No permission will be given to meet any other child except their wards.
- No leave or permission will be granted on any occasion such as marriage, festival, house warming, pooja, etc., during the academic year. Kindly arrange for updating of Aadhar, renewal of passport, etc. during the holidays scheduled by the school.
- Parents are strictly warned against bringing tuck for their children in the school. Feeding your ward on the campus with food brought from outside is strictly prohibited.
- No eatables / money are to be kept in the hostel room / changing room.
- The school celebrates birthdays of all students in the school. Chocolates will be provided in the school store. Parents are not permitted to send gift articles, chocolates for birthday or for any other occasion. They can call their wards only on their wards' birthdays between 4.00 p.m. and 5.00 p.m.
- Parents are allowed to visit their ward's room on the reopening day only. Afterwards, they are advised not to go to any room.
- Students have to report back to school on the date and time specified by the school from time to time, failing which, a late fee of Rs.5000/- will be imposed for each day.
- Students are not allowed to wear any costly jewellery on them or keep any costly articles with them. The school does not take responsibility in case they lose such items.
- The school gives good medical attention to all students. In case of minor ailments, parents are not informed. The school reserves the right to take decisions with regard to emergency medical situation. In case of serious illness or complications, parents are informed and they are required to visit the school immediately.
- We appreciate parents if they check their wards' baggage before dropping them to school to avoid getting objectionable things to the campus.
- Parents of Day Boarding students should monitor their children regularly so that they don't carry undesirable things like eatables, money, gifts, objectionable magazines, mobile phones, etc. to the school.
- Boarding students should write a letter every Sunday compulsorily to parents.
- As you are aware, we have introduced phone call facility for the boarders to communicate with their parents once in a week. However, any detailed communication with your wards should be conducted through letters. Your reply / response to your wards letters will positively boost their morale. In case of any emergency, parents may leave a telephone message for their wards at the school office which will be passed on to them.
- The school reserves the right to modify any of the rules and regulations and it reserves the right to ask parents to withdraw their wards for any act of indiscipline without assigning any reason.
- The school provides all the basic items such as soap, talcum powder, sanitary pads and all stationery items. Students may mention the articles needed, in the requisition slip and get it duly signed by the parent teachers. However, parents are requested to advise them to buy things only in case of dire necessity, to avoid careless handling of things and wastage. You are advised not to send any parcel to the school.
- It is advisable to label all the items brought by the students with their register numbers. It would be better to get them stitched since numbers written with marker pens fade out soon. I to IV - Swimming costumes, inner wear, socks, shoes, etc. should be labelled/tagged
- Students are not allowed to bring any objectionable magazines, pen drive, books or mobile phones into the hostel. Any kind of indecent behaviour of students (like ragging or bullying) will be dealt with sternly.
- Students are expected to take part in all the extra-curricular activities of the school and no one will be exempted.
- All students should converse only in English in the school premises, in order to acquire greater skill in the use of the language.
- Students are expected to have regular haircut. Hair colouring is not permitted.
- Lending and borrowing of things from one another is strictly prohibited. Any student found to have taken other student's belongings will face automatic suspension.
- Boarders are not allowed to enter other student's room at any point of time during their stay in the hostel. Gossiping in the rooms is strictly prohibited.
- Students are not allowed to bring electrical gadgets, except musical instruments. However, this should be brought to the notice of the parent teacher / warden, when brought.
- Participation in morning exercise, sports and games is compulsory except on medical grounds or on doctor's advice.
- Students are not permitted to bring and use medicines on their own. They are warned against self-medication. In case of illness, they can approach the resident nurse or resident teachers available round the clock.
- Parents are advised to inform the school office promptly of any change of address, telephone numbers, mobile numbers, e-mail, etc. so that the records can be updated.
